The Orthopaedic Operation Theatre uses state of the art C-Arm Image Intensifier for intra operative visualization of fracture fixation procedures.

Our Obstetrics department is the best in the district, which possess foetal cardiac monitors and an emergency Operation Theatre exclusively to handle high-risk pregnancies.

We offer excellent neo-natal care, which is unique in the district. Our NICU is equipped with Incubators, Pulse Oxy-meters, Radiant Warmers and Phototherapy units, which take care of pre-term babies and low birth weight infants.
